Title: Regulation of Power Supply to MePDCL by North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Ltd(NEEPCO).

Regulating Agency : North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Ltd. (NEEPCO).

Regulated Agency : Meghalaya Power Distribution Corporation Ltd. (MePDCL)

Reference : Letter No: NEEPCO/ED/COMML/R-16/2018-19/1299 dtd. 22.02.2019 from North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Ltd. issuing Notice for regulation.

Date and time for Commencement of Regulation : 03.03.2019 (00:00 Hrs.)

Duration of Regulation : 6 (six) months or till such time MePDCL liquidates its outstanding dues for more than 60 (sixty) days, whichever is earlier.

Authority : CERC Order dated 28.09.2010 and amendment thereof.

Scheme of Regulation

1. Back ground:

North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Ltd. has proposed regulation of Power Supply to MePDCL.

As per **North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Ltd.** letter vide No: NEEPCO/ED/COMML/R-16/2018-19/1299 Dt.22.02.2019 (Copy enclosed), the outstanding in excess of 60 days have mounted to Rs. 305.93 Crores as on 21.02.2019 plus LPS of Rs. 256.07 Crores as on 21.02.2019. The total amount due as on 21.02.2019 is Rs. 562.00 Crores.

North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Ltd has proposed regulation of 100% [except 6% free share from Kopili, Khandong & Kopili – Stage-II] of allocated share of MePDCL from all the power plants of NEEPCO for 6(six) months or till such time MePDCL liquidates its outstanding dues for more than 60(sixty) days, whichever is earlier. The regulation will be effective from 00:00 hrs of 03.03.2019.

North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Ltd. has intimated that the source of regulation will be all the plants of NEEPCO.

In view of above, the following scheme shall take care of the regulation proposed by **North Eastern Electric Power Corporation Ltd.**

100% of MePDCL share from all the plants of NEEPCO except 6% free share from Kopili, Khandong & Kopili –Stage-II (Round the clock)	6 (six) months or till such time MePDCL liquidates its outstanding dues for more than 60 (sixty) days, whichever is earlier.	All the plants of NEEPCO

2. Proposed diversion:

NEEPCO proposed sale of part or full quantum of the regulated power from all the plants of NEEPCO through IEX as a client member of PTC India Limited during the period of regulation. Further, NEEPCO shall ensure that the total sale of the regulated quantum of power should not exceed the regulated quantum of MePDCL.

3. Regulation:

Regulation will be effected from 00:00 hrs of 03.03.2019. The regulation shall continue for 6 (six) months. The regulation will be done by reducing the schedule at all the plants of NEEPCO. MePDCL will have to regulate its drawl in accordance with RLDC schedule, which will form the part of regulation scheme.

4. Scheme:

- a) The MePDCL shall be advised to draw strictly as per schedule prepared by NERLDC.
- b) For the purpose of daily scheduling, NERLDC will inform the MePDCL of its plant wise normal entitlement as well as total regulated entitlement from ISGSs based on day ahead declared availability by the ISGSs of ER & NER from whom MePDCL has allocation.
- c) MePDCL shall furnish to NERLDC its requisition from these stations as per restricted entitlements.
- d) NERLDC will prepare daily schedule on the basis of the requisition furnished by the MePDCL as at item (c) above.
- e) NERLDC shall monitor the above curtailed drawl schedule in real time from the time regulation is implemented.
- f) NERLDC shall keep Member Secretary, NERPC, informed of the implementation of the regulation of power supply.

5. Grid Security Aspect: Nil

6. Power Supply to essential services:

MePDCL shall ensure normal power supply to sensitive/ important installations like defence, mines, medical, water-supply, aviation etc.

7. Commercial.

In the process of regulation all the commercial arrangement including sale of power by the generating companies or regulating agency to the utility / utilities within / outside the region shall be guided by chapter- III of CERC regulation dated 28th Sept, 2010.

8. Deferment / Withdrawal of regulation.

In the event of Generating utility proposing to withdraw / postpone the regulation, they should follow the procedure as per clause- 9 of CERC regulation dated 28th Sept, 2010.

9. Suspension of regulation.

The RLDC may suspend the regulation in case of:

- i. A perceived threat to system security due to a contingency.
- ii. Adverse impact on other utilities.

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
